

International First-Year Student Admission

Admission requirements for international first-year applicants depend on whether you attended high school inside or outside of Turkey.

If You completed High School within Turkey

Admission requirements will vary depending on your area of study; matching the requirements for first-year applicants who are non-Turkish citizens. Review the list of [Undergraduate Areas of Study](#) or our First-Year Admission Requirements for more details. In addition, you must complete the English language requirements.

If You Attended High School Outside of Turkey

You must meet the following requirements for admission:

Completion of academic upper secondary school (generally a total of 12-13 years of primary and secondary education)

A corresponding secondary school diploma or leaving certificate

Above-average grades in a secondary school program that is university-preparatory in nature

Completion of our Minimum High School Course Requirements, which vary depending on the undergraduate program you're applying to. Admission department will assess this by reviewing your transcript.

Satisfaction of our English Proficiency Requirements

SAT or ACT scores are not required of international applicants who wish to apply for Prudential First scholarship program. If you have taken SAT or ACT, then upload your score card.

SAT and ACT scores also can be used to satisfy the university's English proficiency requirements.

A strong result could favorably affect the decision regarding your scholarship application.

If you Attended High School in the United States or Canada

Admission will be based on a review of US high school transcript or Canadian high school transcript. International students who will graduate from a U.S./Canadian high school are not required to submit English proficiency test and will be exempt from any further language tests.

International Application Deadline

International Student Application Deadline is July 31.

International students are encouraged to apply well in advance of their anticipated enrollment date.

Payable by credit card. Do not send cash. Application fees are not refundable.

Upload your academic records

Within your student Profile on Prudential First, upload all required transcripts from every secondary school, college, university, technical/vocational institute, or professional institution you have attended.

If your first language is not English:

Please upload your TOEFL, IELTS or PTE score, if applicable, based on our English Proficiency Requirements.

Have your ACT or SAT score result uploaded

If you completed secondary school in the United States, then you do not need TOEFL, IELTS and are exempted from English language test.

You must write a 400-500 words essay and upload it in either word or pdf format.

The topic is "Why do you want to study in Turkey"

Admission

We will notify you of our admission decision within 2 weeks after receiving all required documents.

Student visa supporting documents for students living outside of Turkey are prepared only after the University has received the payment. Please make sure that you provide accurate mailing address in your student profile as we'll ship all original documents by courier to the listed address.

Accepting our Offer of Admission

To accept our offer of scholarship and admission to the university, pay the \$1000 acceptance deposit within 15 days of receiving the offer. Any delay will result in loss of the scholarship offer. All scholarship recipients will have to pay the \$1000 acceptance deposit. If you've been awarded with full scholarship and you cannot afford to pay the \$1000 acceptance deposit then you need to furnish financial proof. Waiver will be offered on case to case basis.

The acceptance fee is refundable prior to July 1 fall semester applicants and December 15 for spring semester applicants.

To save time and money, do not send the above documents through courier before getting the scholarship and admission acceptance offer.

You'll upload transcripts, financial statements, financial guarantees and copies of passports via their Admissions Profile. All records should bear the original stamp or seal of the institution and the signature of a school official. Documents not in English must be accompanied by a complete, literal, English translation, certified by the issuing institution. Records cannot be returned or transferred.

Please do not send any other documents than the required letters of recommendation, passport copy, financial statements, transcript copies, TOEFL/IELTS score, SAT/ACT score and personal essays unless the item is specifically requested by the Office of Admissions. Providing unsolicited materials will delay the processing of your application and will not factor into a University scholarship decision. Extraneous items will not be returned to you and will not be retained by the Office of Admissions.

Your next steps may include applying for Turkish visa at the Turkish consulate/Embassy near you and start searching for on/off campus housing and preparing to live in Turkey.
